



Eligibility Guidelines for the Educational Enrichment Foundation's Shoe Shopping Days

- EEF Shoe Shopping Days are regularly held at the beginning of the school year (September), during the holidays (December/January) and in the spring (April).
- Access to EEF Shoe Shopping Days is open to all TUSD school sites with financially eligible in-need students in grades Pre-K – 12th.
- A TUSD representative is the **only person** who can bring students to an EEF's Shoe Shopping Day.
- A student's school site must submit an application to EEF that has been signed by both the student's parent AND his/her school's community representative, principal, counselor, OR family liaison. Please submit this application by fax at least **ONE WEEK PRIOR** to the scheduled Shoe Shopping Day.
- Participating students must be eligible for free/reduced lunch in order to access EEF's Shoe Shopping Days program (please refer to the USDA guidelines provided by TUSD Food Services Department). If eligibility is in question or special circumstances are present, please contact EEF directly. Exceptions are made on a case by case basis by EEF's Executive Director.
- Eligible students may attend one EEF Shoe Shopping Day per school year, though exceptions may be requested.
- Each participant will receive one pair of shoes and a three pairs of socks.
- If demand on a particular Shoe Shopping Day exceeds currently available funding, your eligible student will be given priority for the next scheduled Shoe Shopping Day.
