The mission of Educational Enrichment Foundation (EEF) is to provide resources to expand and enrich student learning in the Tucson Unified School District (TUSD). EEF began in 1983 with a grant from the Ford Foundation to enrich education and learning in TUSD, where 58% of students qualify for free or reduced meal assistance. The first programs provided mini-grants to teachers for special classroom projects. EEF's programs have expanded to provide special needs assistance (shoes, clothing, eye exams and glasses) and scholarships to low income/at risk students. Since its beginnings, EEF has awarded over \$3.5 Million in programs and services to the TUSD family.
